AWARD OF MERIT (rename: AIA ORLANDO ARCHITECTURAL AWARENESS AWARD)

Objectives: This award is given to recognize an individual citizen, public official, or member of an allied profession, who is not an architect, who shall have advanced the cause of good design and planning and/or has enhanced the public awareness of the value of architects and architecture to society.

Eligibility: Any person, who is not an architect, fulfilling the purpose of this award as described, including allied members of AIA Orlando.

Nomination: Nominations may be made by any AIA Orlando architect Member.

Selection: The Board of Directors may select a recipient by a majority vote.

Form of Award: An appropriate Certificate & trophy to be retained by the recipient.
