NILS M. SCHWEIZER COMMUNITY SERVICE AWARD

Objectives: This award is given to recognize an architect whose leadership in community activities and service has been a direct benefit to the profession or community. The individual's leadership and service must demonstrate notable contributions through voluntary service resulting in initiatives, programs or civic influences that have benefited the profession or the community, i.e. conservation, historic preservation, beautification, land-use regulation, livable communities, or the removal of blighted areas, or who have clearly raised the standards of professional performance or public awareness in these areas.

Eligibility: Any member of AIA/Orlando whose leadership in a community fulfills the intent and purpose of this award is eligible.

Nomination: Nominations may be made by any AIA Orlando architect member.

Selection: The Board of Directors may select a recipient by a majority vote.

Form of Award: An appropriate Certificate & trophy to be retained by the recipient.

4. Describe the effect that the architect's leadership and service has had on the profession or community, indicating reasons why nominee is worthy of this award.
5. Attach any photographs, articles, editorials to support the nomination.
