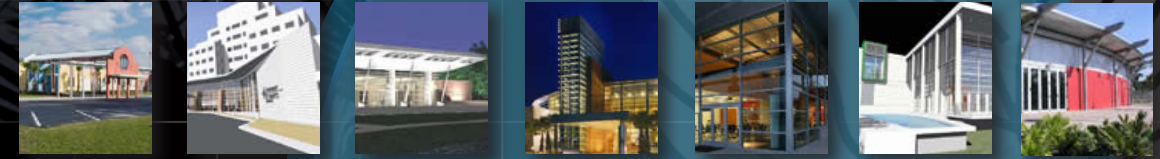

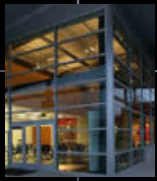

Objectives

To encourage excellence in architecture, bring public awareness to outstanding architectural design, and to honor and recognize those architects whose work enriches our built environment.

Awards

Each submission will be judged solely on the basis of its value toward furthering Design Excellence in Architecture. Honor and Merit Awards may be awarded in each of the categories and project types. Since entries are weighed individually within each category and not in competition with each other. The jury reserves the right to select the number and type of awards. Awards will be announced at the Awards Gala on March 14, 2009.

Categories

There are three basic categories, **Unbuilt, Built or Sustainable**. Project types can be, but are not limited to, the following:

Commercial/Industrial	Healthcare
Historic Preservation/Adaptive Reuse	Entertainment/Hospitality
Government/Justice/Institutional	Educational
Research/High Tech	Residential
Interior Architecture	

The entrant must specify the category of **Unbuilt, Built or Sustainable** for each submittal.

Sustainable Design Award

This award recognizes design excellence in integrating sustainable concepts with traditional design requirements. The completed building shall have received certification for sustainable design from a nationally recognized organization. A copy of the certificate is to be included with the submittal.

Test of Time Award

This category is open to all existing buildings that have stood the test of time. It honors the designers of the classic and early modern buildings that we have grown to cherish. These are buildings which have been completed for over 25 years.

Nils M. Schweizer Award

This prestigious award is given to recognize an architect whose leadership in community activities and service has been a direct benefit to the profession or community.

Award of Merit

This award was developed to give recognition to an individual citizen, public official, or member of an allied profession, who is not an architect, who has advanced the cause of good design and planning and/or has enhanced the public awareness of the value of architects and architecture to society.

Firm of the Year Award

This award recognizes outstanding achievement in design, community services, education, and service to the profession and the AIA by an architectural firm. Projects, accomplishments and service submitted must reflect a period of at least 10 years.

Contractor of the Year Award

This award is given to a company or firm in the State of Florida who has exemplified a sincere and genuine interest in encouraging and affecting outstanding craftsmanship and workmanship. The award is given to a company or firm in Central Florida who has exemplified a sincere and genuine interest in encouraging and affecting outstanding craftsmanship and workmanship on local projects, and has made a significant impact to Central Florida by its active involvement and leadership within the community.

Consultant of the Year Award

This award is given to recognize an individual or company in the state of Florida who, in acting as Consultant to an AIA member, demonstrates consistent dedication to superior standards of design, across a range of projects, and under varying conditions based on exceptional performance in the critical Customer Service areas of Client Focus, Teamwork, Communication, Project Management, Critical Thinking, and Specialist Knowledge.

Fred H. Pryor Young Architect Achievement Award

This award is given to honor and recognize a young architect who consistently demonstrates excellence and exceptional promise. Some criteria include a maximum of ten years out of school (with either a bachelor or masters degree), strong leadership qualities, and community involvement.

The Rules

To be considered for the 2009 AIA Orlando Design Awards, the entries must be architectural projects which are submitted by members of the AIA Orlando, with offices within the chapter's region (Orange, Osceola, Seminole, Lake, and Volusia Counties), though projects may be located anywhere in the world.

Note: Projects that have previously received an award from AIA Orlando are ineligible for the same category of award.

The Submittal

No visible identification or reference to the project name, Architects's name, or firm name is permitted on any material contained within the submittal binder.

1. **Black Binder:** Entry shall be submitted in an 8 1/2"x11" format, using black binders (Ful-VU, Itoya, 3-ring or equal). All pages shall be inserted in clear sheet protectors. Content: The first page is to be titled "Descriptive Data". The content is limited to three (3) typed pages maximum and should include the following:

- Project Category.
- A 150 word executive summary about the project. This will be used in the awards presentation.
- Architect's Statement outlining the basic program, design concept, design parameters, restrictions and/or limitations, extension of concept to materials, organizational principles, building net/gross square feet, major materials, etc.
- For renovation and adaptive re-use projects, clearly differentiate between the old and new construction. Include photographs of the original structure.
- Graphics shall include site plans, floor plans, sections, three-dimensional drawings, sketches, model photographs, as necessary to explain the project.
- A maximum of ten (10) color or black & white photographs of the building exterior and/or interior.
- A CD labeled with firm name and project name **must contain, but is not limited to, all graphic images including plans, sections, elevations, photos, etc. used in the design submission.** A select group of images will be used in the PowerPoint Presentation at the Gala. Each photograph needs to be saved as a JPG, True Color (24 bit or higher) image type, at 300 pixels/inch maximum, with the image size 2" minimum height or width and 6" maximum height or width. Each digital photo file size cannot exceed 1,000 KB.
- The following information shall be placed in a sealed opaque envelope marked "Concealed Identification" and is to be taped to the inside cover of the black binder. Should your entry receive an award, material for announcements, publicity and award certificates will be taken from this sheet. It is the entrant's responsibility to ensure all information (spelling, etc.) is correct:
 - Name and location of project
 - Name and location of architect, firm and/or design team
 - Name and location of consultants
 - Name of Owner/Developer
 - Name of Contractor or Construction Manager

2. **Presentation Board:** The entry also includes one 16"x16" presentation board per project submitted. Due to weight restrictions of the displays, boards are limited to the use of text and images only, mounted on 1/4" black gator board or foam core. Include the firm name (logo), project name, and location on each.

Submission Publicity

All entries will be presented in video or PowerPoint format during the awards presentation. The 16"x16" presentation board will be on display at various local venues including the Awards Gala.

All materials submitted shall not be restricted for publication. AIA Orlando does not assume any responsibility for copyright and/or photographer's fees. AIA Orlando assumes no liability for lost or damaged submittals.
